School/Community Application for a Marilyn DiCarlo Memorial Mini-Grant

Tecumseh Schools Foundation Established: 1984

Purpose and Activities: The purpose of the Foundation is to receive and distribute funds for charitable and educational activities by assisting in the development, implementation, or maintenance of educational program which significantly contribute to the education of Tecumseh Public School district students. Marilyn DiCarlo, a long-time educator and board member of the Tecumseh Schools Foundation who championed the mini-grant program, died on June 11, 2009.

The Foundation will consider awarding a Marilyn DiCarlo Memorial Mini-Grant for enrichment programs, lectures, student assemblies, research and development, innovative classroom projects, special materials, projects which facilitate school and community partnerships and funding cultural and fine arts programs for the students of Tecumseh. The foundation generally considers books, equipment, and supplies to fall under the regular school budget and will usually refuse requests for these items. Busing to special events will be considered on an individual basis, but may be declined.

Grant Range: Minimum of \$100. Maximum of \$1,500. Grant awards will be subject to modification reflected by availability of funds.

Application deadlines: Grant applications may be submitted up until the 10^{th} of September for the fall term; the 1^{st} of January for the spring term; and the 1^{st} of May for summer or future school year projects. Retain a file copy of all application materials.
